## ENERGY SAVING AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY

#### **Winter Fuel Payment**

The Winter Fuel Payment is an annual tax-free payment between £200 and £300. From winter 2024 to 2025, the payment will only be made to those of State Pension age and over who are in receipt of Pension Credit or other means-tested benefits. #### **Home Energy Upgrade Scheme**

The Home Energy Upgrade Scheme is available to Lincolnshire residents and offers energy saving home improvements, like insulation, renewable heating systems and solar panels. #### Warm Home Discount Scheme

You could get a one-off £150 discount off your electricity bill for winter 2024 to 2025 under the government's Warm Home Discount Scheme. If you're eligible, you'll usually get the discount automatically and your electricity supplier will apply the discount to your bill. #### **Discretionary Housing Payments**

Discretionary Housing Payment can provide extra money to help residents in receipt of Housing Benefit or the housing element of universal Credit with housing costs including:

- Rent deposits Rent arrears
  - A shortfall between housing benefit and rent
- Rent in advance or housing costs included in Universal Credit and rent Moving costs

#### Safe. Warm and Well Grant

A maximum grant of £10,000 is available for minor essential repairs to make homes safe and warm for either vulnerable owner occupiers or private tenants with full repairing responsibilities, who are aged over 65, have children aged 14 or younger, or have chronic or severe mental or physical condition and are living in homes in need of heating or safety improvements. #### **Gas Central Heating Scheme**

Up to £10,000 to provide a gas central heating system and installation for owner occupiers with a chronic or severe mental or physical condition exacerbated by cold.
